All ages, ranks and experience levels are welcome to participate in this event and coaches are an integral part of the process of how competitors will be matched. Matches are offered at the discretion of the competition organisers and acceptance of any match play is at the discretion of the participant's coach. Once a match is accepted the player moves to that division and there are no additional medals for the original division.

Any changes requested after closing date will attract a \$15 Administration Fee (Admin fee does not apply to changes to provide for matchplay when offered by organisers)

ENTRY FEES

1st Event \$45 (sparring) / \$35 (technical) - Additional events (either) \$20 Exceptions: Jump Kick \$10 with ALL entries PAID IN CASH on the day

Timber \$5 per board paid at time of entry

Yun Hap club does not charge a spectator fee - We encourage everyone to support our raffle on the day!

REFEREES / JUDGES please ensure you register. Honoraria will be paid electronically on the day so please ensure you have your bank account details available.

COACHES are also asked to register for the event to assist us with planning.

EVENT DETAILS

SPARRING

Standard weight divisions apply wherever possible and we will ask your actual weight. Outside of that we will match you as close as we can and coaches will let us know if the match is suitable. We match by age, rank and weight (so we'll ask weight when you register for the event). While we appreciate that some parents are highly experienced we reserve the right to deal only with coaches in regard to match planning.

Use of Daedo electronic scoring systems is compulsory for black belts and red belts and preferred for blue and yellow belts. If blue and yellow belts cannot access electronic footguards then non-electronic scoring will be utilised.

HEAD KICKS apply for:

- red and black belt cadets
- blue, red and black belt juniors (15-17) and seniors (18-30)

Head kicks are OPTIONAL for:

- all ranks for Masters
- yellow belts juniors (15-17) and seniors (18-30)

(If one opponent in a match elects to have no head kicks then there will be no head kicks)

NO HEAD KICKS applies for all yellow and blue belts aged 12-14 and ALL divisions below 12 years.

Round times will be:

15-17 and Open Red and Black Belt 3 x 1.5min rounds All other ages and ranks 3 x 1min rounds

POOMSAE

All competitors will be scored using iPoomsae system.

Individual competitors will perform 2 patterns OF THEIR CHOICE from the following poomsae:

White/ Yellow Belt Kibon, Taegeuk 1, 2 or 3

Blue Belt Taegeuk 3, 4, 5 or 6

Red Belts (plus Cho Dan Bo)

Taegeuk 6, 7, 8, Koryo 1 or Koryo

Black Belts – 1st to 3rd Dan Any black belt pattern

Black Belts – 4th Dan and above Any black belt pattern (1 pattern must be above Taebeck)

Pairs (2 people, any gender), Teams (3-5 people, any gender) and Family will perform 1 pattern OF THEIR CHOICE. Entries will be split into appropriate groups and penalty points may apply if the performed pattern is deemed to be inappropriately low for the team's average rank.

TIMBER BREAKING

Each TECHNICAL BREAKING competitor will receive 5 x 12mm boards. No additional boards may be used. Scoring sheets will be published at www.yunhaptkd.com.au and only broken boards will count in the score. Boards will cost \$5 each and must be PAID IN CASH on the day before medal presentations.

POWER BREAKING will be utilising a stand, will use 19mm boards and 3mm spacers. Participants will either punch in a downward action or strike with a hammer fist and must have at least 1 foot on the floor when breaking. Weight divisions may apply.

JUMP KICK

Competitors will be split into reasonable height groups on the day irrespective of age, gender and rank. Competitors must perform a JUMP FRONT KICK and land on their feet. Only 2 attempts will be allowed at any height. If the final 2 competitors both miss then heights will be reduced /increased until a winner is determined. All jump kick entries will be PAID IN CASH on the day.

The jump kick competition will be a progressive entry. This means that competitors can elect the height at which they enter the competition and the group doesn't all have to start at the same height, with competitors joining in when the target reaches their selected commencement height.

SELF DEFENCE

A scenario presentation performed by 2-4 participants with a maximum time limit of 1 minute. Judged based on effectiveness of techniques and fluency of presentation. Scoring sheets will be published at www.yunhaptkd.com.au for information and to assist you in preparing presentations.
